

# Relational Discipleship

## Listening:

- Affirm what is correct; keep asking questions to point them in the right direction
- Ask, Admire, Admit
- Ask like a lawyer
- Be a question expert!
- Clarify/repeat back
- Do what you hear down the road



## Relational:

- Relationships are not found in book study format
- Relational discipleship sometimes throws aside the study to teach life navigation
- Relational discipleship is more powerful studying Jesus/ the Bible and applies to their walk
- Relationships start in your home, but they move beyond
- Relational discipleship is two-sided
- Relational means getting messy.



## Creating Healthy Boundaries:

- Be careful what inner voice you become
- Your family comes over discipleship, but not idolatry
- Call your sin “sin”. There is no need to glorify it.
- Leave your disciple, and their burdens, at the cross.
